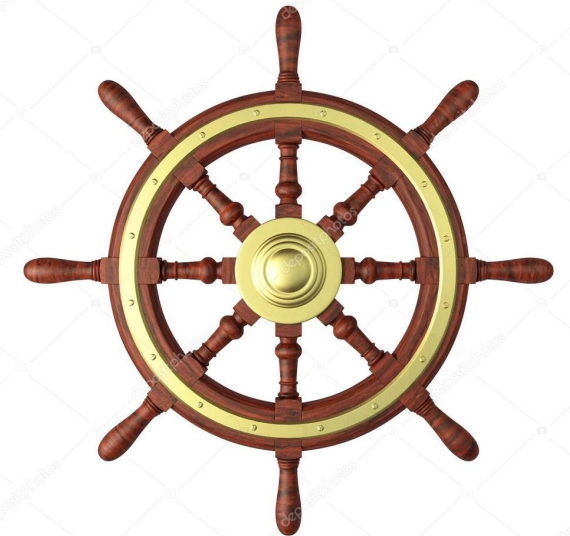

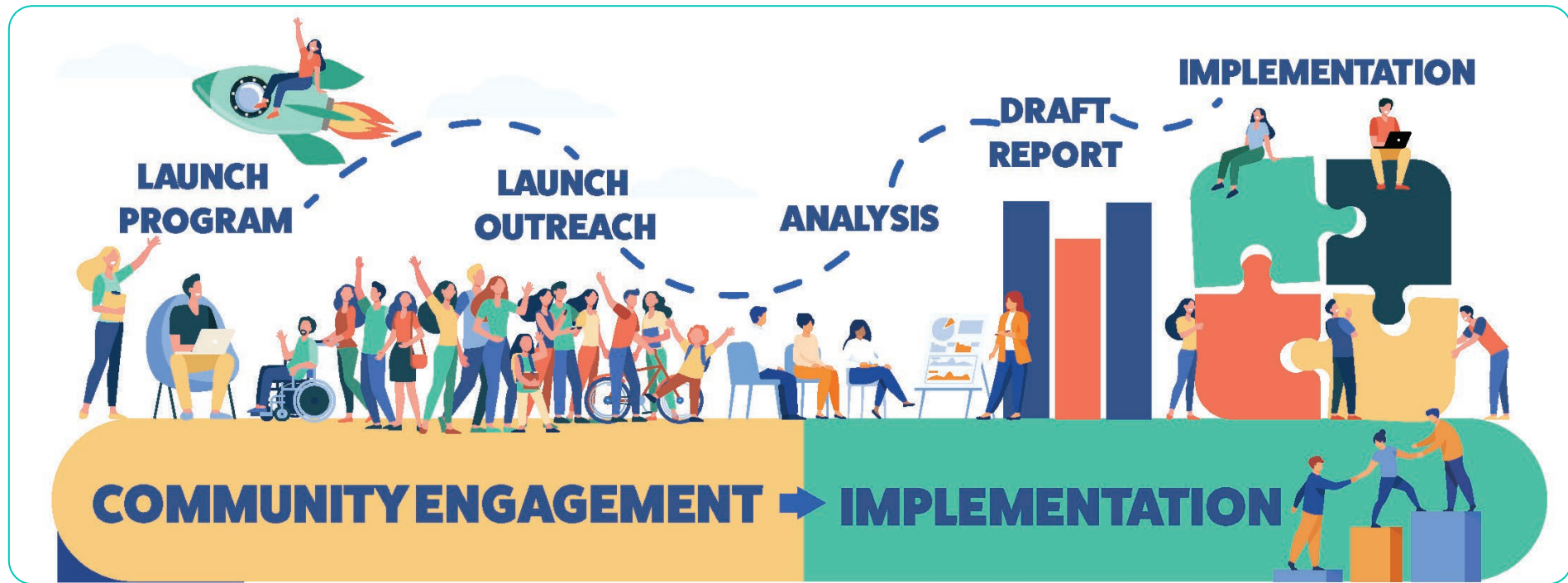




# STEERING GROUP ROLE

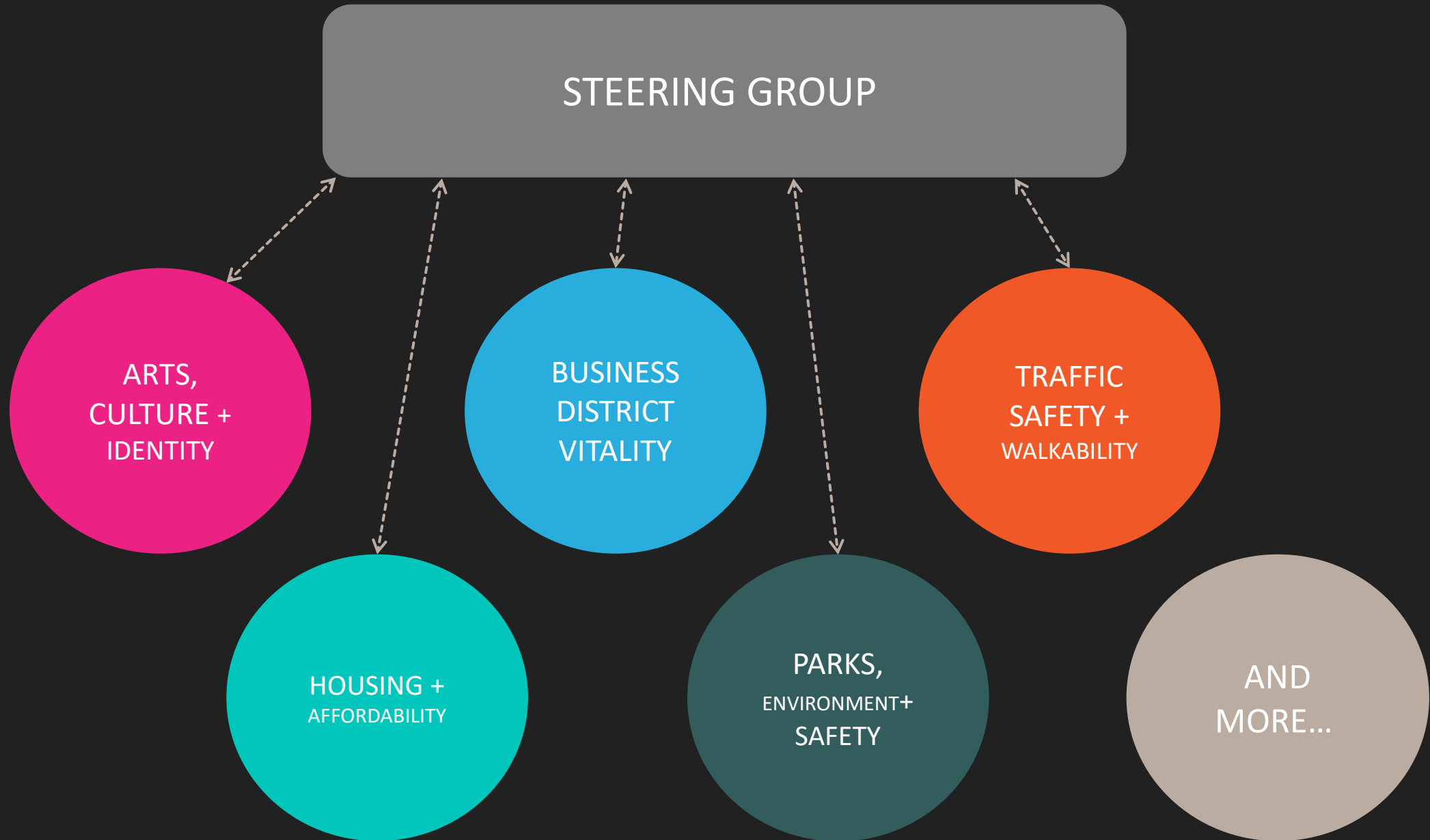
